A high-profile senior analyst for CNN and staff writer for *The New Yorker*, **Jeffrey Toobin** is one of the country's most esteemed experts on politics, media and the law. Toobin has provided analysis on some of the most provocative and important events of our time, including the O.J. Simpson trial, the Kenneth Starr investigation and impeachment of President Bill Clinton, and the disputed Florida recount of the 2000 presidential election.

The author of critically acclaimed *New York Times* bestsellers, Toobin's 2007 book *The Nine: Inside the Secret World of the Supreme Court*, delves into the historical, political and personal inner workings of the Supreme Court and its justices to reveal the inside story of one of America's most mysterious and powerful institutions. Toobin's renowned bestseller *Too Close to Call: The 36-Day Battle to Decide the 2000 Election* is the definitive story of the Bush-Gore presidential recount.

Toobin received his bachelor's degree from Harvard College and graduated magna cum laude from Harvard Law School, where he was an editor of the *Harvard Law Review*. He later served as an Assistant United States Attorney in Brooklyn, N.Y., before joining *The New Yorker*.

Toobin lives in New York City with his wife and two children.
